



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
## Look back...


## Look back...


## Look back...

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
# Infrastructure which depends on lone fighters is not robust

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

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


Juggling is not software development, but jugglers use (and develop) software!

# What is the situation on my server?

- One virtual server, which powers [pesth.org](http://pesth.org), [jonglaria.org](http://jonglaria.org), [conventiontickets.de](http://conventiontickets.de) and [lheurebleue.xyz](http://lheurebleue.xyz), costs are around 11€ per month + costs for the domains
- Convention registration software pretix, 2024 it was used for 11, 2025 for 12 conventions, the biggest one was Nürnberg
- Own mail server
- Mailing lists of 3 juggling clubs as well as three themed mailing lists (Passout / Con-Orga-All Stars / Server information list)
- Especially for jonglaria
  - Bengelsystem for the planning of volunteer shifts
  - Fileserver (Nextcloud) incl. video conferencing (currently quite restricted)
  - Doodle to coordinate meeting dates
  - Wiki
- Experimentally
  - Self hosted Openstreetmap vector map
  - Car- / public transport / pedestrian routing
  - Geocoding (reverse as well)

## What worries me about my server?

- A lot of sensitive data at one place (contact data and banking numbers of >1000 jugglers!)
- GDPR issues
- Bus factor
- Backup concept
- Update concept
- In general no clear liability

- **Forming a group**

There are many technical versed jugglers, who are well informed and can pull it off! A technical support group could support all jugglers who could use help.

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Could be possible if purpose of funding in the statutes of the “parent club” allows complete technical operations.

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If we organize ourself in an independent non-profit organization for the public good (german organization form “Gemeinnütziger Verein” liability issues could be taken over by this organization.

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- **Umbrella organization of “Gemeinnützige Vereine”**

The umbrella organization would be “gemeinnützig” i.e. accepted as organization for the public good in germany automatically

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## Recognition as a sport

- There are no hard rules by the law, what should be recognized as a sport in the sense of tax privileges (except chess), a lot of tax offices are probably orienting themselves on the criteria of the “Deutscher Olympischer Sportbund” (german olympic sports confederation).

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- Admission regulations DOSB:
  - $\geq 8$  state associations
  - 10000 members

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- unicycling seems to be easier recognized as a sport than juggling (?)

## Non-profit association types

### ■ **Independent association**

Support for the general public does not exist if the group of persons benefiting from the support is fixed, for example, membership of a family or the workforce of a company, or if, as a result of its demarcation, in particular according to geographical or professional characteristics, it can only ever be small. Support for the general public does not exist solely because a corporation transfers its funds to a public corporation.

### ■ **umbrella organization**

All member associations must be non-profit organizations. As soon as a member loses its non-profit status, it must be expelled from the association.
